All stalk corn must be cut at base before ears. 10 Ears of Corn for all Corn Samples

Lot 3 - 2 Stalks any White Hybrid Corn

Lot 4 - 10 Ears Early Maturity Yellow Hybrid

Lot 5 - 10 Ears Medium Maturity Yellow Hybrid

Lot 6 - 10 Ears Full Maturity Yellow Hybrid

Lot 7 - Any Variety, Maturity Group III

Lot 8 - Any variety, Maturity Group IV-early
